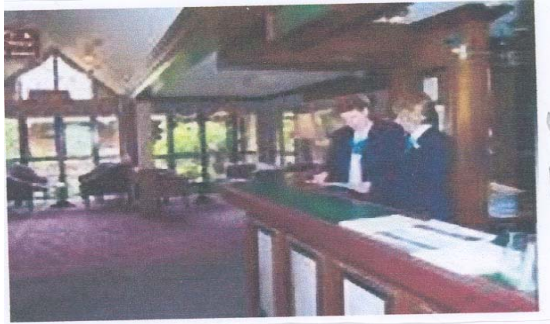
A group of American technicians specialized in medical equipment have just arrived at Algiers airport to train Algerian health technicians to use a new-brand type of x-Ray scanner.


Task 5 :


On the contrary, when they are not the same age and are not really friends, they use “**Formal**” English.

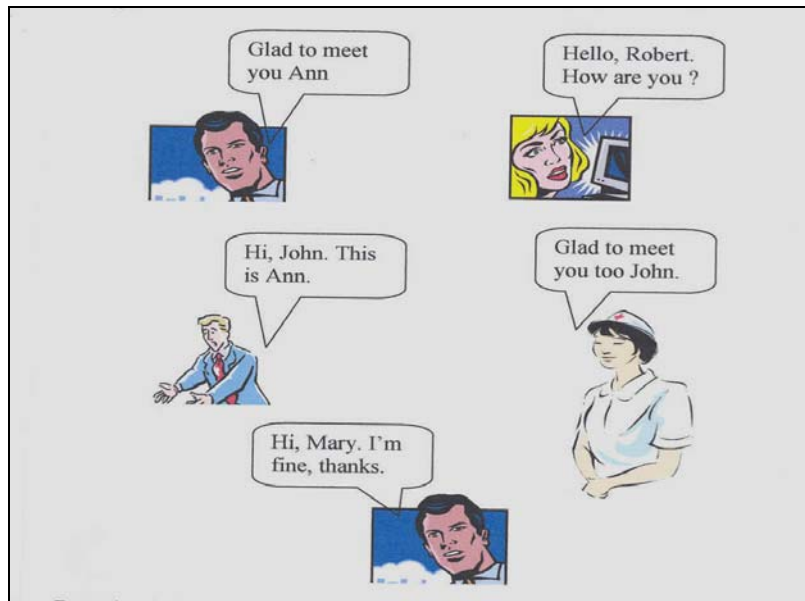
